Just Opened: Soto, Sandro's

Atlanta's Sotohiro Kosugi has transplanted **Soto**, his revered strip-mall shrine to sushi, to Greenwich Village (357 Sixth Ave.; 212-414-3088). Expect the chef's prix fixe guided tour of Japanese cuisine to go well beyond the usual tempura, fish and rice.

Speaking of restaurant reincarnations, chef Sandro Fioriti has revived **Sandro's** on the Upper East Side (he opened the original Sandro's on East 59th Street with Tony May in the 1980s). The straightforward Italian menu is served till 2 AM, Monday through Saturday, and is complemented by house-infused grappas in flavors like peperoncino and rosemary. The new address is 306 East 81st Street (212-288-7374).
